Between being an active business owner and traveling the world for pleasure, Sharon had little time to address her outdated kitchen and surrounding living spaces. After a disappointing experience with a remodeling contractor, we were able to bring the incomplete project to its beautiful completion as evidenced by the project photos.

Twenty-five year old white cabinetry was replaced with a premium cabinet line in a warm chestnut finish with custom rope moulding details. Special order backsplash deco tiles were chosen with a fleur de lis pattern to evoke the French Country feel Sharon was looking for. Through a carefully designed floor plan, we were able to give her a small island for food prep as well as a dining height peninsula for casual meals. We also designed a built-in bookcase to house her teapot collection and flat screen television for viewing during her morning coffee.

The sunroom was added as a vaulted space off the existing kitchen and dining areas. Bringing the French Country to life in this room was a real treat for us. Custom furnishings were designed around this motif which included two Chervan arm chairs, and a locally fabricated custom loveseat and ottoman in Tapestry, Robert Allen and Stout fabrics. Roman shades with delicate medallion accents were added to the windows for privacy as this room faces a busy street. Antique reproductions were mixed with iron and granite pieces, in addition to a custom sideboard used to display Sharon's many treasures. A cool blue was chosen for the wall paint to reflect the calm and serenity of this room. Sharon spends many hours in this space and she says it is now her favorite room in the house.
